In 2024 alone, almost 15 million Postcode Lottery players raised €969 million for 500 major charity partners and thousands of grassroots initiatives, locally and globally.

Our funding philosophy

The Postcode Lottery Group was founded in 1989 on trust-based philanthropy – a belief that we, the lotteries together with our players, are the fundraisers, and the charities and social organisations are the experts who know best how to use the funds.

We offer flexible and long-term funding, with funding relationships based on trust. Our partners – whether established charities or smaller community initiatives – have the freedom to use funds where they are needed most, whether that means covering core costs, investing in innovation, or responding quickly to emerging challenges. This trust-based approach creates space for innovation and lets them focus on what matters: supporting people and driving change.





We strive to keep our grant processes simple and "light touch," listening to what our grantees need and providing them with support that is flexible and respectful. We do not just fund projects, we empower people.

When local change makers have trust and support, they have the power to improve lives in small ways and in big ways.

Our players have fun and win prizes and at the same time help strengthen the communities they are part of. This model of neighbours helping neighbours has created a unique spirit of shared purpose Together, we are not only funding projects but also fostering collaboration, joy and hope in neighbourhoods and communities around the world.

Community and neighbourhood funding

At the Postcode Lotteries, we support local initiatives through our major, established charity partners who distribute funds locally, and directly via our own Lottery Foundations, Trusts and Funds.

This way our players see the difference they make - near and far. That is why we have always supported smaller, local initiatives that strengthen communities and bring people together.

Funding areas include strengthening social cohesion, supporting vulnerable people within the community, inclusion, mental wellbeing, improving green spaces and preventing poverty.

The funds support a wide range of good causes: from exercise classes, meet ups to help combat loneliness, domestic abuse support, to money management classes and help for people experiencing homelessness.

A better world starts here

Each of the following examples, highlights the diversity of projects that are made possible thanks to our players.

The numbers represent more than money – they stand for playgrounds rebuilt, community

gardens planted, social clubs formed and lives touched in every corner of our communities. They show the strength of locally led initiatives to find answers to today's challenges, starting small but often expanding and inspiring others to reshape our society.











A shared vision with a local touch

The Postcode Lotteries believe in empowering ordinary people to improve their own communities.

Each Lottery has developed its own approach to community and neighbourhood funding. From small grants for community initiatives to strategic partnerships with local charities. Each country's programme aims to open the door to funding. Be it through a quick online application in Sweden, a simple form for a community association in the Netherlands, or feedback for all applicants in Great Britain.

The similarities are evident: small grant sizes (often several thousand euros, kronor or pounds) aimed at local impact, fast decisions and an emphasis on projects that build social ties or address neighbourhood needs. In every country, players are reminded what their support is making possible – a neighbour playing the Lottery means the neighbourhood wins too.





Each Lottery also tailors its approach to community funding to meet local needs.

In the Netherlands, the Postcode Lottery Neighbourhood Fund is operated by the DOEN Foundation.

The fund provides small grants to local neighbourhood initiatives that improve local surroundings and foster connection and collaboration among residents. It also offers long-term, flexible funding to innovative community initiatives, with an often more entrepreneurial focus and aims for broader and sustainable impact. These include efforts like neighbourhood-run enterprises that boost local economies and create lasting change beyond the neighbourhood level.

The VriendenLoterij engages supporters of sports and culture clubs in the Netherlands, effectively turning fundraising into a fun team effort at the grassroots level.

Sweden's approach reflects the country's strong tradition of social cohesion and access for all. Projects are funded that allow neighbours to meet and new connections made. Projects are spread across the country, ensuring that even the smallest communities feel seen and supported.

In Great Britain, the Postcode Lottery operates in a highly developed charity sector. It stands out by trusting the good causes it funds, offering multi-year funding and combining community grants with a sense that charities win too - not just our players.

In Germany, the Deutsche Postcode Lotterie has Postcode Partners - organisations that receive long-term funding that is not tied to specific projects. At the same time, it also funds thousands of smaller organisations, community and volunteer initiatives which make up the majority of the approximately 6,500 organsations that the Lottery has supported with more than €330 million since 2016.



Winning together

Community funding programmes have become an important part of what we do at the Postcode Lotteries.

With the Postcode Lottery, it is not just our players that win, charities and communities win too.

Thousands of local, community initiatives are winning and transforming neighbourhoods and people's lives in postcodes near and far thanks to the almost 15 million people who play the Postcode Lottery.
